Rides are also listed on the white board inside the RHD shop. If you would like to lead a ride, you don't have to be a road captain, just let Harley Tom know.

If you lose contact with the group you are riding with, due to stoplights, heavy traffic or other circumstances, there will be a road captain or another member waiting up the road for you. There is also a sweep person on every ride. Harley Tom would like to see a road captain leading, one in the middle of the group and a sweep at the end.

Safety Officer: Charlie Milligan and Harley Tom demonstrated the acceptable hand signals while out riding on your bike. Charlie M also wishes the club to know he is not an official Historical Site! The 2011 statistics quoted there are 404,000 licensed motorcycles, and 230,000 registered motorcyclists. 10% of fatalities are motorcyclists.

If you are 55 or older you get a discount on the Old Fart's motorcycle safety classes!

Charlie also gave us this advice for on the road. If someone cuts you off in traffic, or pulls out in front of you, FIDO = Forget It Drive On. It isn't worth the hassle to have road rage. Be safe out there and be alert. Remember the 2, 4 and 12 second rules of stopping while on a freeway or busy highway.

Charlie has many handouts up front on the table: Riders Course Training, Laws and regulations from state to state, mirror laws, Dunlap Tire Guides and the Motorcycle Safety Foundation.

MN dial a ride is a 1-800 number that will get you and your motorcycle home safely.

ABATE is struggling with their membership and these are the people who back us and help us out.

CPR demonstrations will be held after the meeting by Gordon Haubenschild. First aid kits are available also for \$10, from the American Red Cross.

## **Around The Bend**

---

AROUND THE BEND! For those that don't know, my name is Charlie Milligan and I am the SAFETY OFFICER for the S.E. MN HOG CLUB. I've been thinking about doing this for some time and "there is no time like the present". I have never written a "COLUMN" before so I hope YOU will bear with me as I get started. I hope that all of us can share any tips, ideas, requests or whatever that may impact the safety of all of us—or any one of us.

As the name implies, what do we actually know "AROUND THE BEND"? We can ride the same road every day forever, but it only takes that one time when there is an xxx (chose your own critter, vehicle or other obstacle) in the road. With training - and some luck-hopefully we can avoid an "incident".

My point is, the price we pay for the enjoyment of motorcycling is the need to be CONSTANTLY aware of not only what is going on in front of us (around the bend) , but also what is happening on the side of the road, BEHIND us and even in our own thoughts and actions-daydreaming, talking etc. Taking a Motorcycle Safety Course - information is available at the HD Shop or from me if you want - will provide you with some accident avoidance tips and things to do in an emergency. We are NEVER TOO OLD to learn!!

If you have attended a meeting recently, you know one of my pet peeves is CHECKING YOUR TIRE PRESSURE! There are some very good tire pressure testers available in the parts department. When the valve stem is in the center of the rim, it can be a little difficult to get a good reading. The parts department has one that has the testing head at a right angle to the body that simplifies that process. The correct pressure for your tires is on a sticker attached to the lower front of the frame down tube. It is usually on the right side-easy to see. This is a COLD pressure. The pressure will rise or fall with temperature, usually about 1 lb for every 10 degrees. The pressure on the side of the tire is NOT what is supposed to be run in the tires, it is the MAX pressure in/for the tire. Because of where we live, we can see the air temp alone rise and fall a lot over the course of the season and in turn the tire pressures.

Along with the pressure, also keep an eye out for your tire tread depth. There is not a lot of tire on the road at any one time and it is important-especially if it is wet or raining- that the tread is such that "HYDROPLANING" (the tire actually riding on top of the water) can be minimized. When your bike is in for service, the shop will always check the tread depth for you.

Well, that's enough for the first time. I hope some of the information I wrote about today is useful and not TOO boring. As I mentioned at the start, please feel free to offer any suggestions or ask any questions. Anything that can help even one of us out of a bad situation is IMPORTANT!!
