Around the Bend

GET YOUR MOTOR RUNNIN-HEAD OUT ON THE HIGHWAY! Thanks to STEPPENWOLF for that great song from 1969! Kinda ties in with this month's column. Yea, might not exactly be ridin weather here yet-although a buddy near Fairmont was out last w/e- but there are a few things to consider especially if you are goin south or west for a vacation.

I have talked about it before, but if you are goin somewhere WARM (hopefully and taking your bike,) make sure you, your bike, and your INSURANCE are ready for the trip. I just picked up my license tabs for 2015-got yours? Good idea to get em and put em on if you are taking your bike. At the least, it may prevent a stop by the authorities. Once stopped, things like insurance (bike AND health in some states), handlebar height -some states(Fl. in particular) have strict requirements, blue dots-probably ONLY legal in Mn.-, mufflers- or the lack of-may be inspected and the DB reading taken, foot pegs for all riders, and licenses-both your ride and your own! An extra note on mufflers, some states/cities only classify as "legal" mufflers that have a DOT date stamp on them concurrent with the year of the bike. Most states require you have a copy of the vehicle registration and insurance with you. I always try to have a copy of both not only on the bike, but with me-AND this includes the vehicle you may haul the bike in/on. Since I mentioned hauling the bike, if it's on/in a trailer, some states have a separate speed limit for vehicles pulling a trailer so watch those speed limit signs.

So, how bout if ya go somewhere and rent a bike? Check with your insurance before you pick up the bike. MOST bike insurance does NOT cover a rental, unlike renting a car. I have rented many places and I, personally, buy all the insurance. It is not that expensive typically, and you will probably not be keeping it for a long time. In all likelihood, the rental agency will require wearing a helmet. Typically, they have some you can use. I leave it up to you on that. It may not fit or be the kind you normally wear and it may contain "passengers" you may not like!! All the bikes I have rented were in good shape etc but still, give a quick once over and make sure it is sound and fits you ok.

Guess I should mention something about safety! Ya gotta watch out for different things in different areas. AHH, the SUN, the BEACH, the ----- (you fill that in). All good, except when the sand starts blowin across the road. Sometimes it can be hard to see but beware, it can make a road very slippery. We've all most likely ridden in rain, but rain mixed with this sand can be very tricky as well. Any mention of safety, especially if it is in Fl., would not be complete without talkin about the "steel grate bridge decks". Usually, they are over the canals in the Intercoastal Waterway. If you have never ridden over one, the best thing to do is let the bike "steer" itself. You may feel some wobble or hula as some call it in the handlebars. I have found a light grip on them without trying to over-correct is the best idea. Now, if you're ridin an old shovel or sporty with a ribbed front tire, you're on your own!! Speakin of the ol' hula, some southern AND western states have some very deeply "grooved" roads. Same theory applies with the light pressure on the bars.

OK, you're really enjoying the warm weather and the road BUT! Depending on where and when you are, there may be another half million or more tryin to do the same things. Traffic in some of these places can be a bear to say the least. I try to find backstreets to avoid having a motor melt down in traffic. Unfortunately, lots of others do too but try if you can. Piece of advice if you're in Daytona, DO NOT try to go over the main street bridge from the mainland in the afternoon! Traffic backs up horribly!! NUFF SAID!

Last word on all of this and applies to anywhere ya go. Check the local laws. Lane-splitting is legal in Ca. and the first time someone goes by between you and a BUICK, it will for sure get your attention. Right turn on red,

riding two abreast on the road, special speed limits, NO BIKES ALLOWED, etc are some things you may see. OK, Try to have a GREAT time and DON'T give a second thought to those who are stuck--in the snow—in the cold—in the house—back home!! BUT, above all:

LET'S BE CAREFUL OUT THERE!!!
